Circular regarding IA-1 and PT-1

Dear Parents/ Guardians,

Greetings from St. Xavier's School Nevta!

As communicated earlier in the circular dated May 21, 2021, Internal Assessment-1 and PT1 will be commencing from July8, 2021 and July 26, 2021 respectively. Keeping in mind the current situation of the country the classes will continue to be online only and the Examination will also be conducted online for all classes. However, in order to eliminate certain handicaps and unfair practices followed by the students during online exams and also to improve face to face interaction, the school has made a few changes in the mode of assessment this year. Kindly go through the following points regarding the same.

1. Internal Assessment-1 (Beginning 7th July 2021 for Classes 1 to 5) (Beginning 8th July 2021 for Classes 6 to 12)

The Internal Assessment this year will be a combination of Oral (face to face) and regular Class Tests for all classes. The details are mentioned below

For Primary School

- The **ORAL TEST** will be of 10 marks comprising of 5 questions of 2 Marks each. The test shall be conducted by the respective subject teachers **between 12pm-1pm** on working days. **It is mandatory for all students to appear for the Oral Test with their device Camera switched on. No Student will be given permission to appear for the test without turning their cameras on under any circumstances. The Parents are requested to make necessary arrangements well in advance. A stable Internet connection is imperative.**
- **Regular Class Test:** The students will be assigned an objective paper comprising of 'Multiple Choice questions, Fill ups, One-word answer or True/ False etc. The test shall be conducted during the regular class of the respective subject teachers.

It is mandatory for all students to appear for the Oral Test with their device Camera switched on. No Student will be given permission to appear for the test without turning their cameras on under any circumstances. The Parents are requested to make necessary arrangements well in advance. For Senior School (Class 11-12)

- The ORAL TEST/ FACE TO FACE TEST will be of 10 marks comprising of 3 to 5 questions. The test shall be conducted by the respective subject teachers between 7:30 am to 9:00 am on all weekdays (including saturdays). It is mandatory for all students to appear for the Oral Test with their device Camera switched on. No Student will be given permission to appear for the test without turning their cameras on under any circumstances. The Parents are requested to make necessary arrangements well in advance. A stable Internet connection is imperative.
- **ASL details for English** will be shared by the respective subject teacher. These tests will be conducted in regular teaching periods by the teachers.

Special Note for Classes 6 to 12: In case owing to technical reasons the oral test for all students is not completed within the given time period, some students will be required to appear for the test after 1:30 pm on the same day whichever time feasible for both teachers and students. Here we expect full cooperation from parents and students

2. Periodic Test -1 beginning 26th July 2021

The Online PT1 Exams for all classes shall commence from July 26, 2021 and are expected to end by August 6th2021. The question paper of each subject shall be of **40 Marks and will comprise of Objective as well as Subjective questions**. The timetable for the same will soon be uploaded on the Schools Website. Teachers will further enlighten the students about the details of the same. No regular classes will be there during exam days.

The lessons covered in Internal Assessment will also be taken up for PT1. Kindly prepare for exams accordingly. Since exams are fast approaching, the students are expected to be regular and attentive during the classes. Study well!

The syllabus of these tests will be shared in class by the teachers. There will be no retest on any pretext. Students are advised to strictly adhere to the schedule and appear for the test.
