While submitting the representation in this regard, please ensure that details viz Name, Father's Name, Date of Birth, BOARD Roll number and Stream are correctly mentioned along with the TYPE of dispute (TYPE 1/2/3/4) as mentioned in the CBSE circular indicated above.

Further, based on the guidelines of the CBSE all the communication sent to school earlier, before issuance of this CBSE circular, will not be considered and all concerned are required to **make the representation individually afresh** to the school on <u>result2021@stxaviersschoolnevta.in</u> mentioning all the necessary details.

CBSE has given the deadline for submission of individual representations to the schools, however, in order to make necessary exercises at school level, kindly adhere to the following time schedule strictly facilitating the school for scrutiny of individual cases and onward transmission to the BOARD.

SPECIAL NOTE:

1. According to the CBSE the students who are not satisfied with the results declared and wish to appear for the Improvement Exam, a separate communication is under issue which shall be communicated on receipt.

2.Students who wish to apply for admission in any institution including Delhi University should apply before the last date of submission of application in the school without waiting for the final disposal of their dispute. CBSE / School will not be responsible for any delay occurred due to the conditions beyond control, as intimated by CBSE.
